



THE CRACKDOWN BEGINS NOW!

Karaoke Music Piracy is THEFT. To combat this serious crime, the Special Copyright Task Force has been cracking down on commercial users and karaoke dealers distributing and selling pirated karaoke songs since **10 May 2010**.

Make sure your karaoke songs are legal or you and your business will face severe consequences -
a fine of minimum RM2,000 up to RM20,000 per infringing karaoke song and/or imprisonment of up to 5 years.

Criminal charges and civil liability aside, you are also putting your reputation at stake.

PROTECT YOURSELF AND YOUR KARAOKE BUSINESS AGAINST LEGAL ACTION

- 1 Conduct a full audit of your karaoke music licences immediately
- 2 Ascertain the legality of the karaoke songs contained in your computers by contacting RIM or PPM at **603-6207 2888**
- 3 Keep all proof of licences for inspections or raids that may take place
